BYLAWS OF

TENNESSEE ALLIANCE FOR LEGAL SERVICES

ARTICLE 1: Name and Address

This corporation, which formerly conducted business in the name of the Tennessee Association of Legal Services, shall do business in the name of the Tennessee Alliance for Legal Services. The board of directors shall have the power to designate other names for specific activities and programs as it deems appropriate. The principal address shall be:

ARTICLE 2: Purpose

The corporation's purpose shall be:

- 1. To coordinate efforts among interested persons and organizations to establish an integrated delivery system that insures that every low-income person in Tennessee has timely access to the civil legal justice system and that identifies conditions that adversely affect low-income persons in Tennessee and to implement strategies to develop resources to change those conditions.
- 2. To support and coordinate the activities of the providers of civil legal services to the poor in Tennessee, by providing such services as training, communication, unified approaches to common state and federal funders, information about state-based activities that impact the providers and their clients, and by providing training to provider staff and the other attorneys who work on behalf of their clients.

ARTICLE 3: Membership

Members of the board of directors shall constitute the membership of the corporation.

ARTICLE 4: Board of Directors

A. Membership: The Board of Directors shall include representatives of organizations that provide civil legal assistance to the indigent or other leaders of the equal justice community. Additions or deletions of organizations or institutions that have representatives on the Board of Directors may be made by giving 30 days notice prior to a Board of Directors meeting. The vote is concluded by simple majority.

- 1. The board of directors shall include representatives of the following providers of civil legal assistance and statewide professional positions that support equal justice providers as outlined below. These members are designated as appointed directors:
 - a. The Executive Director or his or her designee and one other representative (making for a total of two representatives) from each of the following:
 - (1) Memphis Area Legal Services
 - (2) West Tennessee Legal Services
 - (3) Legal Aid Society of Middle Tennessee and the Cumberlands
 - (4) Legal Aid of East Tennessee
 - b. The Executive Director or his or her designee from each of the following:
 - (1) Tennessee Justice Center
 - (2) Disability Law and Advocacy Center (formerly Tennessee Protection and Advocacy)
 - (3) Southeast Tennessee Legal Services
 - (4) Southern Migrant Legal Services
 - (5) Community Legal Center
 - (6) Justice For Our Neighbors
 - (7) Tennessee Volunteer Lawyers for the Arts
 - c. Designee of the following law school based programs:
 - (1) Belmont University School of Law
 - (2) Lincoln Memorial University Duncan School of Law
 - (3) Nashville School of Law
 - (4) University of Memphis Legal Clinic
 - (5) University of Tennessee Legal Clinic
 - (6) Vanderbilt University Legal Clinic
 - d. Persons or his or her designee holding the following positions:
 - (1) Tennessee Bar Association Access to Justice Coordinator
 - (2) Tennessee Bar Foundation Executive Director
 - (3)Tennessee Supreme Court Access to Justice Coordinator
- 2. In addition to those members who serve by virtue of their professional positions as listed in Article 4. 1. a, b, c and d, the Board of Directors shall include up to ten (10) members that comprise a diverse group of leaders from the equal justice community. These members are designated as elected directors.
- B. Terms. Each elected director shall serve a three year term. Initially elected directors shall be allocated so that approximately one third of those directors terms expire annually. Appointed Directors shall not have limited terms. Elected directors shall serve for no more than two consecutive terms.
- C. Vacancies. Vacancies of elected directors may be filled for the unexpired term by a majority vote of the board.

D. Removal:

- 1. a. An elected director who has missed three or more consecutive meetings may be removed by a majority vote of the board members in attendance at a meeting at which a quorum is present.
- b. An elected director may be removed for any other reason by a vote of two-thirds of the members in attendance at a meeting at which a quorum is present.
- 2. An appointed director shall be removed only upon the withdrawal of the program from the Alliance or by removal of the program from the Alliance.

No person may be removed from the board, and no organization may be removed from participation in the Alliance, without being given 30 days written notice prior to a Board of Directors meeting at which the removal may be considered.

D. General Powers.

- 1. Authority. The board of directors shall constitute the governing body of the corporation. The board shall manage the business and affairs of the corporation. It shall have all powers necessary to carry out the objectives of the corporation as set forth in Article 2. The board may accept or reject, on behalf of the corporation, any contribution, bequest, or devise. The board shall have the authority to hire and dismiss the executive director as may be necessary in order to carry out the objectives of the corporation.
- 2. Meetings. Meetings of the board of directors shall be held at least four times each year, at a reasonable time and place designated by the Chair. The Chair may designate additional meeting dates. One-third of the board members then sitting may, by written request, schedule additional meetings.
- 3. Annual Meeting. The board of directors shall designate one meeting per year as the "Annual Meeting."
- 4. Notice of Meetings. Board members shall receive 10 days notice of regularly scheduled meetings. This notice may be given in writing, in person, by telephone, or by any other reasonable method.
- 5. Waiver of Notice of Meeting. A director may, in writing, waive notice of any meeting of the board of directors either before or after the meeting, and such waiver shall be deemed the equivalent of giving notice. Attendance of a director at a meeting shall constitute waiver of notice of that meeting, unless attendance is for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of business because the meeting has not been lawfully called or convened.
- 6. Adjournment. A meeting of the board of directors may be adjourned. Notice of the adjourned meeting or of the business to be transacted there, other than by announcement at the meeting at which the adjournment is taken, shall not be necessary. At an adjourned meeting at which a quorum is present, any business may be transacted which could have been transacted at the meeting originally called.

- 7. Informal Action. If all the directors severally or collectively consent in person, in writing, via telephone, or via e-mail to any action taken or to be taken by the corporation, the action shall be as valid as though it had been authorized at a meeting of the board.
- 8. Attendance by Telephone. If a member is not reasonably able to attend a meeting, a majority of the members present may authorize participation by telephone, so long as the absent member can hear, or be advised of the discussion of business, and other members can hear, or be advised of the absent member's votes or comments. An absent member participating by telephone may count toward a quorum.
- 9. Proxy Voting. Absent members may not vote via proxy through a member in attendance.
- 10. Resignations. Any director may resign at any time by giving notice of resignation to any officer of the board.
 - 11. Quorum. A quorum shall be one-third of the directors then sitting.
- 12. Committees. The Chair or two-thirds of the board of directors may appoint any committee it deems necessary to help fulfill its functions.
- 13. Compensation. Pursuant to program policies, directors may request reimbursement for out-of-pocket expenses.

ARTICLE 5: Officers

1. Officers. The board of directors shall have a chair, a vice-chair, a secretary, and a treasurer. Any person may hold two or more offices except that the chair shall not also be vice-chair, secretary or treasurer. Officers are elected annually and serve for the TALS fiscal year which is also the calendar year.

Duties of Officers.

- a. The chair shall preside at all meetings of the board and executive committee. The chair shall appoint members to standing and ad hoc committees. The chair shall perform whatever duties the board of directors may from time to time assign.
- b. The vice-chair shall carry out the duties of the chair when the chair is absent or incapacitated; shall have the same power and duties as the chair when acting in that capacity; and shall perform whatever duties the board may from time to time assign.
- c. The secretary shall have charge of such books, documents and papers as the board of directors may determine; shall keep, or cause to be kept, a true and complete record of the meetings of the board of directors; shall give, or cause to be given, notice of all meetings of the directors; shall keep, or cause to be kept, a record containing the names, alphabetically arranged, of all persons who are members of the corporation, showing their places of residence, the names of persons entitled to

participate in corporate affairs. Such books shall be open for inspection as provided by law. The secretary shall, in general, perform all the duties incident to the office of secretary subject to the control of the board of directors and shall perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the board of directors.

- d. The treasurer shall have custody of all corporate funds, property and securities subject to such regulations as may be imposed by the board of directors. The treasurer shall keep, or cause to be kept, full and accurate accounts of receipts and disbursements and shall deposit, or cause to be deposited all corporate funds and other valuable effects in the name of and to the credit of the corporation in a depository or depositories designated by the board of directors. Corporate funds may be deposited only in banks or institutions which are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or the Federal Savings and Loan Insurance Corporation. The treasurer shall give to the president or board, whenever they require it, an account of transactions as treasurer and of the financial condition of the corporation and shall, in general, perform all duties incident to the office of treasurer, subject to the control of the board of directors.
- 3. Committees. The Corporation shall have an Executive Committee and four standing committees and any additional standing as may be voted upon by two-thirds of the members then sitting. The Board shall adopt a charter for standing committees. The chair can appoint any additional committees on an *ad hoc* basis as need arises. The chair will also appoint the members of any *ad hoc* committees.

The standing committees shall be:

- a. Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall consist of 11 members, who shall be the Chair, the Vice-Chair, the Secretary, the Treasurer, the immediate past Chair, the four executive directors or their designees of the providers described in Article 4. A., and two at-large officers as designated by the chair with the consent of the Executive Committee membership. If the position of Secretary and Treasurer is combined to be held by one person, then that person shall serve on the Executive Committee on behalf of both positions. This committee shall meet as needed to plan for the board's work and to fulfill tasks assigned to it by the board.
- b. The Development Committee. This committee shall consist of not less than five persons appointed by the Chair. Upon a vote of two-thirds of members then sitting, the board may appoint additional members to this committee.
- c. The Fiscal/Audit Committee. This committee shall consist of not less than four persons appointed by the chair. Upon a vote of two-thirds of members then sitting, the board may appoint additional members to this committee. The treasurer shall serve as chair of the Fiscal/Audit Committee and the chair of the board will be a member of the committee.
- d. The Training/Conference Committee. This committee shall consist of not less than five members appointed by the chair.

ARTICLE 6: Staff

- 1. Executive Director. The executive director is responsible for administering the program of the corporation. The executive director is accountable to the board of directors and shall work closely with the board to fulfill its objectives. The executive director, as authorized by the board's fiscal policy, shall sign or delegate authority to sign checks and enter into agreements with the approval of the board of directors, which are necessary to carry out the objectives of the corporation. The executive director may hire other staff members as the board of directors authorizes. The executive director shall be an ex officio member of the board, entitled to notice of and attendance at meetings, except those portions of a meeting at which matters directly relating to the director are discussed.
- 2. Other Staff. All other staff shall be supervised by and accountable to the executive director.
- 3. Hiring policies. Hiring shall be conducted in full compliance with the corporation's anti-discrimination policy. The corporation shall hire no employees who are members of the immediate family (spouse, grandparents, parents, brother or sister, or son or daughter) of any board member, or of any person who will supervise the employee.

ARTICLE 7: Finances

- 1. Fiscal Year. The organization's fiscal year will be the calendar year. Upon a vote of two-thirds of members then sitting, the board may change the corporation's fiscal year.
- 2. Budget. The board of directors shall prepare and adopt a budget for the coming year at its final meeting of each year.
- 3. Annual Financial Statement. The corporation shall prepare an annual financial statement for distribution to board members.
- 4. Fiscal Policy. The board shall adopt and from time to time review a fiscal policy setting out a formal procedure that shall govern the signing of checks; the obligation of funds; approval of contracts, leases, deeds and mortgages; and other significant aspects of the organization's fiscal operation. The fiscal policy shall assure that the corporation shall have sound financial controls that are appropriate, under generally accepted accounting principles, to its size and purpose. Changes to the fiscal policy will be adopted by a vote of the-Board of Directors.
- 5. Seal. The corporation will not use a common seal. The signature of the name of the corporation by an authorized person shall be legal and binding.
- 6. The corporation will have an annual financial audit certified by an independent Certified Professional Accountant. The Board must accept the audit by a majority vote.
- 7. Fiscal/Audit Committee. The Board chair shall appoint not less than four members to a fiscal/audit committee that shall be responsible for, among other duties, reviewing the corporation's annual audit, its financial controls, its annual budget, and other aspects of its fiscal operation. The committee shall make recommendations to the board on such activities.
