Delta Academy provided educational and enrichment activities in Math, science and technology for girls ages 11-14.

During the 2005-2006 year, there were 25- 35 actives participants in Delta Academy, although 45 girls were admitted to the program. The activities for the Academy included:

Awarding of Scholarships

Nine (9) \$1,0000 scholarships were awarded to graduating under represented female high school students based on the following prescribed guidelines and criteria:

- I. Applications for the scholarships are mailed to high school guidance counselors in the Nashville Metropolitan, Davidson County area. A flyer announcing the scholarships is attached so that the guidance counselors can copy and posted areas where students can see the announcement. Additionally, sorority members are encouraged to to identify female students who meet the criteria
- 2. Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:
 - A. Be a graduating senior with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
 - B. Submit transcript with ACT and/or SAT scores. seven semesters of grades must be reflected and current classes.
 - C. Practiced good citizenship.
 - D. Participated in extra-curricular activities.
 - E. Submit two letters of recommendation.
 - F. Submit a three hundred (300) word or less essay, providing background information, and outlying future plans and aspirations.
