ALIAS has a pending draw for a committed FY 18 grant award from the Metro Nashville Arts Commission in the amount of \$2,117, on a grant period ending 6/1/18. ALIAS also has \$3,000 yet to be drawn from a current, confirmed TAC grant for FY 18 on a grant period ending 6/15/18. These grant funds are paid on a reimbursement basis, so at times ALIAS uses funds in cash reserves until reimbursements are received.
