Pursuant to the provisions of Section 48-60-105 of the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act, the undersigned domestic nonprofit corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Charter:

1. The name of the corporation is:

Tennessee Public Schools Forum.
2. The text of the Amendment adopted is as follows:
 - (a) The name of the corporation is hereby changed to:

Tennessee State Collaborative on Reforming Education.
3. The Amendments were duly adopted on the 3rd day of November, 2009, by the Board of Directors of the corporation, there being no members of the corporation.
4. The corporation is a nonprofit corporation.
5. The additional approval of the Amendments by some person or persons other than the Board of Directors is not required pursuant to T.C.A. Section 48-60-301.
6. The Amendments shall be effective when these Articles of Amendment are filed by the Secretary of State of Tennessee.
