Also through this program 30 youth were able to attend Barefoot Camp, a week long Christian camp in Kentucky. Ten high school students participated in Servant and Leadership Training (SaLT). SaLT combines mentoring (each student receives mentoring and provides mentoring to a younger student), academic support, and life skills development.
