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BAHATI'S JOURNEY

Abducted twice by two different rebel groups — first at 10 years old, then again at 15 — Bahati was one of the most traumatized young men to have entered into EI's care programs. Due to the severe violence he witnessed and was forced to participate in, he battled nightmares, flashbacks, an other symptoms for years.

Through EI's programs Bahati was restored and empowered t be a leader in his community. In addition to graduating from EI's care program, Bahati has also graduated from secondary school and recently started university.

After returning to his village, Bahati started leading a Bible study with active rebels from one of the very groups that onc abducted him!

Additionally, **Bahati and two more EI graduates started a car program** in their village — a village that has been ravaged by years of war, fighting, and rebel activity. For more than a year they have been serving and leading 85 rescued child soldiers utilizing the counseling curriculum that helped them heal th own wounds, leading peace-building and conflict resolution activities, and so much more.

HOLISTIC REHABILITATIVE CARE

From basic needs of any child — food, water, and shelter — to meeting the emotional and psychological needs of children recovering from the deep scars of war, trauma and loss...

EI strives to see each child succeed and excel – not just during their times with EI, but also as they launch into successful lives! This requires long-term investments from caretakers who understand each child's cultural and social dynamics — providing each child with the very best in psychological care, mentoring and discipleship.

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ROADMAP TO HEALING

El care programs are **restoring and empowering** waraffected children through holistic, rehabilitative care providing **physical, emotional, and spiritual restoration**. El also provides education, housing, food, and medical care.

Utilizing a **three-tier**, **curricula-based model** of (1) art-focused trauma care, (2) peace-building and conflict resolution, and (3) leadership development, El empowers child survivors of war to become leaders who will transform communities for Christ.

ABDUCTION & CAPTIVITY

12 Years Old — average age at abduction 3 Years — average time in captivity ESCAPE OR RESCUE (often by UN)



ART THERAPY

Art is an empowering medium for children to express and process emotions and experiences they do not yet have the words to share.

Therapeutic programs incorporating art, music, dance and drama provide children with avenues to share their stories. For many, this expression becomes the first step on **a path of healing and discovering hope**.

By communicating their stories with caregivers, mentors and peers, children are able to **rebuild a sense of normalcy** – the knowledge that "I can be understood" – once lost to extreme physical and emotional

LETTER FROM JANET

"I was abducted in August on a Saturday at 4 am. I was just 11 years old. My friends tried to escape, but they were killed right in front of us using a machete. The rebels made some of us kill them so that we would learn not to escape. We feared them so much and because of that we did not try to escape.

Sometimes we would walk for 2 days and nights without food or rest. Many children died because they were hungry, tired, weak or wounded. Many of the girls were taken and forced to be wives and slaves for the rebels... sometimes becoming pregnant and having children at very young ages.

Today I thank God who brought me out of that situation alive. I know God loves me. I am now able to have safety, food, Bible study, and I am even able to go to school. I am in wellbeing and I stand because of you.

Thank you for all you do for me and what you continue doing for me.

I am the luckiest girl in the world."

GLORIA Uganda

When Gloria was only 2 years old, the LRA army murdered her father & abducted her mother – leaving her and her siblings behind. In 2013, she and her siblings came into El's sponsorship program where they are not only receiving an education, but the care and guardianship of loving caregivers.



JOSHUA DR Congo

After being rescued by the UN, Joshua faced a difficult road towards healing—persistently plagued by illness & nightmares from his time in captivity. Today, Joshua is healthy – physically, emotionally & spiritually – and leads a discipleship group for 30 rescued child soldiers in his village... a group he started and leads all on his own!

BUDGET

Thanks to you, programs are expanding and meeting more children's needs every year! In other words — more children are healing from the wounds of trauma and more child survivors are being empowered to thrive!

- \$110,000 in new funding for capital expenses for programs & facilities





decrease in post-traumatic stress and emotional wounded-ness

Trauma recovery and progress for youth is measured using the CRIES Test — a trauma severity test designed for use with children. Post-tests show a 78% decrease in posttraumatic stress reactions and symptoms. And that's just Phase 1 of El's care program!
