### Child & Family Permanency



**39**

children completed intensive pre and post-adoption counseling through our Connecting Kids program.

**46**

children in foster care over the age of 12 participated in FCS' Wendy's Wonderful Kids program, which helps older foster care children find forever families.

**121**

caregivers, mostly grandparents, received counseling and practical supports while providing a stable home for 329 children of relative parents unable to care for them.

**99%**

of children in permanency programs maintained family placements and did not enter or re-enter foster care.

### Counseling & Community Based Services



**464**

families in our Family Focused Solutions program overcame significant barriers to employment and moved closer to independence from public assistance.

**618**

school-age children participated in character development programs led by FCS at local public schools.

**3,611**

school children and parents received supportive services including clothing, school supplies, referrals to social services, and much more at Family Resource Centers operated by FCS in local public schools.

### Crisis & Information Services



**185**

clients received intensive financial education classes, credit repair, and debt reduction assistance at new FCS Financial Education Workshops.

**5,241**

people called FCS Health Assistors for help finding affordable health care, medications, and insurance. 1,830 enrolled in health insurance.

**33,981**

people in need called the Crisis Lines for everything from loneliness to suicide.
