expenses. All administrative functions are done off-site with donated staff time. The Outreach Center serves an average of 120+ persons
on a daily basis. Other programs include: rent/utility assistance, transportation assistance, clothing/hygiene assistance, computer lad and
employment readiness, faith programs, meetings and studies, re-housing assistance, and the like as well as case management support.
