Afterschool Program: PTM served over 115 children in three afterschool sites. The format of each site was similar: academic rotations of math, reading and homework. Reading specialists provided reading instruction that enabled over $60 \%$ of PTM students to improve their reading level by more than a grade level. Also, 75 students (K-10th grade) participated in a seven week summer program that allowed for a variety of enrichment options (art, music, sports, gardening, dance, step, field trips, and foreign languages). PTM also provided a "Fun Friday" enrichment program that gave students enrichment opportunities (visual art, dance, drama, gardening, tennis, soccer) and opportunities to perform. Over 100 children participated in a variety of field trips throughout the year, deepening their opportunities for "joy-filled friendships" and "God-inspired dreams".

Calvin House / Youth Program: With this program, over 50 6th-12th grade students took part in weekly gatherings for a meal, Bible study, and opportunities for games. Through these gatherings positive peer groups have formed and have continued to build. Additionally, through this program there are 20 high school students who take part in weekly small group Bible study. This youth program also provides opportunities for week-end retreats and special outings. In J anuary, 201020 high school students went on a snow ski retreat. In April, 201020 junior high students went on weekend retreat focusing on team building. Also, through this program 50 PTM students were able to attend Barefoot Republic Camp, a week long camp in Kentucky. Out of this program developed Servant and Leadership Training Program (SaLT) which provides for 8 high school students an opportunity to receive one on one mentoring, to mentor one-on-one, to have Life Skills training, and to develop academically through tutorials.
 Mentoring Programs: PTM students have an opportunity to be in "joy-filled friendships" through a variety of ways. 80 students have lunchmate mentors (who eat weekly with a student in a school cafeteria) 25 students participated in springbreak in the Marketplace (a program providing job-shadowing opportunities). There are 8 students who have been involved in Thursday morning Breakfast and Bible Study. In this program they are mentored spiritually by an adult in a one-on-one relationship.
