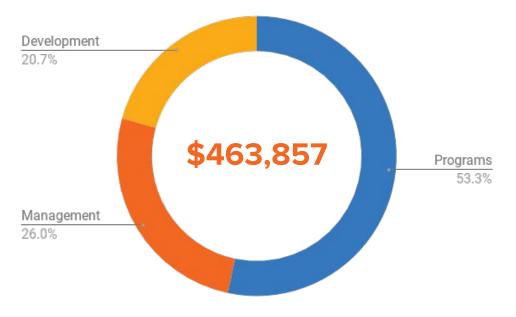

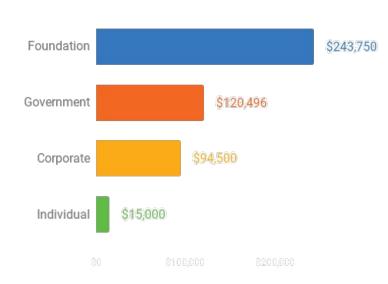


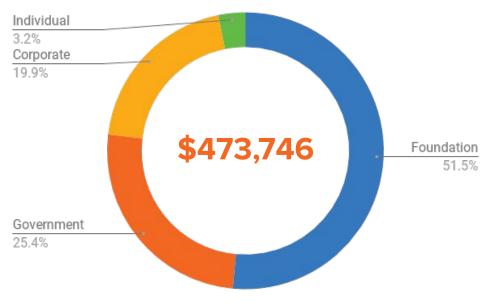


## Education remains our top spending priority.

Combined education programs (Sustainable Classrooms, the Roundtable, etc.) are the largest single expense, with salaries making up 75 percent of the entire budget.





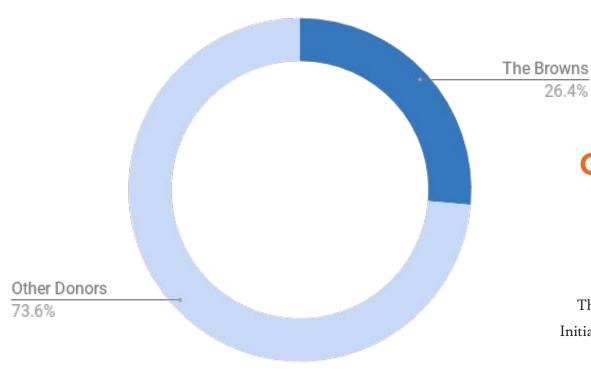


## Foundations are now our largest stream.

Foundations -- many from private industry -- make up our largest revenue stream for the first time. Individual\* projections, while key for sustainable growth, remain low.
