Dear Samantha Singer-Swofford:

We are in receipt of the Annual Exemption Request of Volunteer State Seal Of Biliteracy for review as required by T.C.A. § 48-101-502(d)(2) of the Charitable Solicitations Act. After reviewing the documentation submitted, an exemption for Volunteer State Seal Of Biliteracy as an organization which receives gross contributions from the public of less than \$50,000.00 annually, pursuant to T.C.A. § 48-101-502(a)(2), is confirmed. **Please note this is an annual filing requirement and is due six months after the end of the organization's fiscal year.**

In the event that Volunteer State Seal Of Biliteracy exceeds \$50,000 in public contributions, the organization is required to register with the Division within 30 days, pursuant to T.C.A. § 48-101-502(a)(2). A civil penalty of up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000) may be assessed for any violation of the Tennessee Charitable Solicitations Act.
