## 5. Calendar 2016 Financial Summary

- We completed 53 projects for 28 schools and organizations, compared to 75 projects and 42 schools and organization in 2015
- $90 \%$ ( $88 \%$ in 2015) of expenses were project-related (shop \& project supplies). Recurring annual expenses were $8 \%$ of expenses and $2 \%$ of expenses were volunteer-related. (12\%)
- $67 \%(77 \%)$ of revenue came from our products. $33 \%(23 \%)$ from grants and donations. For the first time, we received funds from Amazon Smiles
- Our Total expense of $\$ 25,762.13$, a decrease of $\$ 9,410.19$ from 2015
- Our Total income of $\$ 32,327.51$, a decrease of $\$ 123.93$ from 2015.
- We made a profit of $\$ 9,565.38$
