BYLAWS OF

ANCORATN (ATN)

These Bylaws regulate the affairs of Ancora^{TN} (ATN), formerly known as End Slavery Tennessee, a Tennessee not-for-profit public benefit nonprofit corporation (the "Corporation"), subject to the provisions of the Corporation's Charter and any applicable provision of the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act §§ 48-51-101, et. seq. (the "Act").

ARTICLE 1

Offices

- **1.1 <u>Principal Office</u>**. The principal office of the Corporation shall be located at any place within or without the State of Tennessee as designated in the Corporation's most current Annual Report filed with the Secretary of State of Tennessee. The Corporation may have such other offices, either within or without the State of Tennessee, as the Board of Directors of the Corporation may deem advisable from time to time.
- **1.2** <u>Registered Office</u>. The Corporation shall have and continuously maintain at 4725 Brick Church Pike, Goodlettsville, TN 37072, in Davidson County, a registered office and a registered agent whose office is the registered office as required by the Act. The address of the registered office and the registered agent may be changed from time to time by the Board of Directors of the Corporation ("Board") without amending these Bylaws.

ARTICLE 2

Purpose

2.1 General Purpose. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, and to prevent cruelty to children within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). Without limiting the foregoing, the principal purposes for which ATN is organized is (a) to support and conduct non-partisan research, education and informational activities to increase public awareness of human trafficking, both foreign and domestic; to combat human trafficking within the United States; and to directly provide to and otherwise make referrals to social services for victims of all forms of human trafficking, through programs in support of the Mission Statement adopted by the Board of Directors; (b) to alone or in cooperation with other persons or organizations, do any and all lawful acts and things that may be necessary, useful, suitable or proper for the furtherance, accomplishment, or attainment of any or all of the purposes or powers of the Corporation; and (c) to solicit, collect, receive, accumulate and administer and disburse funds in such a manner as will,



in the sole discretion of the Board, most effectively operate to further the above stated purposes that qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code.

2.2 <u>Mission Statement</u>. The Board shall adopt a Mission Statement reflecting the activities and purposes of the Corporation. The Mission Statement will be periodically reviewed by the Board and may be revised without revision to these Bylaws.

ARTICLE 3

Members

3.1 No Members. There shall be no members of the Corporation.

ARTICLE 4

Directors

- **4.1** <u>General Powers</u>. All corporate power shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the direction of, the Board of Directors, subject to any limitations set forth in the Articles. The Board shall be self-perpetuating by election in accordance with these bylaws.
- 4.2 <u>Number and Term</u>. The number of Directors shall be a minimum of five (5) and may vary from time to time up to thirty (30) by resolution of the Directors without amendment to these bylaws. The Directors may from time to time, by amendment to these bylaws, change the maximum number of Directors but in no case shall the number be less than three. Each Director shall serve for a term of two (2) years. Directors shall be eligible for no more than two (2) uninterrupted three (3) year terms with the following exceptions: a) the immediate past Chair and Officers shall continue as a member of the Board of Directors for one year following his or her service in the office of Chair/ as an Officer without regard to the number of his or her prior consecutive terms as a Director; b) an initial appointment as a Director to serve the remainder of an unexpired term shall not count toward the three (2) consecutive term limit. Upon ceasing to serve as a Director for any reason except removal by vote of the Board of Directors, a former Director may serve on any Advisory Body.
- **4.3 Election**. Directors shall be elected bi-annually by the Directors of the Corporation then in office at each annual meeting of the Board of Directors, by a majority of those Directors eligible to vote at such meeting. If the election of Directors shall not be held at such meeting, such election shall be held as soon thereafter as conveniently may be. Each director shall hold office until the first of the following to occur; until his/her successor shall have been duly elected and shall have qualified; or until his/her death, or until he/she shall resign in writing; or until he/she shall have been removed in the manner hereinafter provided.
- **4.4** <u>Removal and Resignations</u>. Any member of the Board of Directors may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Chairperson of the Board or to the Secretary of the



Corporation. Such resignation, which may or may not be made contingent on formal acceptance, shall take effect on the date of receipt or at any later time specified therein. Any member of the Board may be removed at any time by resolution adopted by a majority of this Board of Directors.

- **4.5** <u>Compensation</u>. Directors shall receive no stated salaries for their services, but by resolution of the Board of Directors the expenses of attendance, if any, may be reimbursed for each regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors, provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed to preclude any Directors from serving the Corporation in any other capacity and receiving reasonable compensation, therefore.
- **4.6** <u>Annual and Regular Meetings</u>. An annual meeting of the Board shall be held at such time and place as the Chairman of the Board may direct upon at least ten days' prior notice in writing to all of the directors of the Corporation for the purpose of electing officers and the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the meeting. The Board may provide by resolution the time and place, either within or without the State of Tennessee, for the holding of regular meetings without other notice than such resolution. If the election of officers shall not be held on the day designated herein for any annual meeting, or at any adjournment thereof, the Board of Directors shall cause the election to be held at a special meeting of the Board as soon thereafter as conveniently may be. The Board of Directors may provide by resolution the time and place, either within or without the State of Tennessee, for the holding of additional meetings of the Directors without other notice than such resolution.
- **4.7 <u>Special Meetings</u>**. Special meetings of the Board may be called by, or at the request of, the Chairperson of the Board, the Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation or any two Directors of the Corporation. All special meetings of the Board shall be held at the principal office of the Corporation or such other place as may be specified in the notice of the meeting.
- **4.8 Notice of Meeting.** Notice of any special meeting of the Board of Directors shall be given at least two days previously thereto by written notice delivered personally or sent by mail, or email to each Director at his or her address as shown by the records of the Corporation. If mailed, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when deposited in the United States mail in a sealed envelope so addressed, with postage thereon prepared. If notice be given by email, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when the fax or email is transmitted and confirmed sent. Neither the business to be transacted at, nor the purpose of, any regular or special meeting of the Board need be specified in the notice or waiver of notice of such meeting, unless specifically required by law or by these bylaws.
- **4.9** <u>Waiver of Notice</u>. A Director may waive any notice required by the Articles, these Bylaws or Tennessee law before or after the date and time stated in the notice. The waiver shall be in writing, signed by the Director entitled to the notice, and filed with the minutes or corporate records. A Director's attendance at or participation in a meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting, unless the Director at the beginning of the meeting, or promptly upon the Director's arrival, objects to the holding of the



meeting or transacting business at the meeting because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened.

- **4.10 <u>Quorum and Voting</u>**. Unless the Articles require a greater or lesser number, two-thirds of the members plus one member shall constitute a quorum of the Board; provided, however, that if less than a majority of the directors are present at said meeting, a majority of the directors present may adjourn the meeting from time to time without further notice. When calculating two thirds of the members, rounding up to the next whole number is required. Where a quorum is present, the vote of two-thirds of the members plus one member for or against a motion shall be considered a majority vote of the Board.
- **4.11** <u>Manner of Acting</u>. The act of the majority of the directors at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board, unless otherwise required by the Articles or these Bylaws.
- **4.12 Remote Conferencing.** Directors may participate in and act at any Board of Directors meeting through the use of telephone, Internet or other communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can communicate with one another. Participation in such meeting shall constitute attendance and presence in person at the meeting of the person or persons so participating. In the event any meeting shall be so held, the results of any vote taken shall be recorded in writing and signed by all Directors present regardless of their position taken in any particular vote.
- **4.13** <u>Vacancy on Board</u>. Any vacancy occurring in the Board of Directors to be filled by reason of an increase in the number of Board members or resignation or termination of a Board member shall be filled by the Board of Directors as soon as practical. A Director so elected to fill a vacancy shall be elected for the unexpired term of his or her predecessor in office.
- **4.14** <u>Chair and Vice Chair of the Board</u>. The Board may appoint one of its members Chair of the Board. The Chair of the Board shall preside at all meetings of the Board. The Board may also appoint one of its members as Vice Chair of the Board, and such individual shall serve in the absence of the Chair and perform such additional duties as may be assigned to the Vice Chair by the Board. If desired, the Board may appoint two Co-Chairs in lieu of a Chair and Vice Chair.
- **4.15** Advisory Board. The Board may at any time and from time to time create an Advisory Board or Committee ("Advisory Bodies") to give advice and assistance to the Board in one or more aspects of the Board's activities. The Board shall have the power to appoint and remove members of the Advisory Bodies at any time and from time to time in the Board's sole discretion, and to terminate the Advisory Bodies in their entirety at any time and from time to time. The Board shall have the authority to define the scope and role of the Advisory Bodies from time to time within the limits set forth above, and to prescribe the procedures and rules governing Advisory Bodies' operations. An Advisory Body may or may not have Directors as members, as the Board of Directors determines. An Advisory Body may not act on behalf of the Corporation or bind it to any actions but



may make recommendations to the Board of Directors or to the officers of the Corporation.

4.16 <u>Honorary Directors</u>. Individuals who have rendered exemplary service to the organization through membership on the Board of Directors, financial support, or other contributions to the mission of the organization may be elected by the Board as Honorary Directors. Honorary Directors shall be entitled to attend all meetings of the Board but will not have the right to vote.

ARTICLE 5

Officers

- **5.1 Officers.** The Officers of the Corporation shall consist of a either a Chair & one or more Vice Chairs (in descending order) or two Co-Chairs, a Secretary, and a Treasurer, each of whom shall be elected by the Board at its annual meetings. Such other officers and assistant officers and agents as may be deemed necessary may be elected or appointed by the Board. Any two (2) offices may be held by the same person, except the offices of Chair/Co-Chair or Secretary may not be held by the same person concurrently.
- **5.2** Appointment and Term of Office. The officers of the Corporation shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors at the regular annual meeting of the Board of Directors. If the election of officers shall not be held at such meeting, such election shall be held as soon thereafter as conveniently may be. Vacancies may be filled or new offices created and filled at any meeting of the Board of Directors. Each officer shall hold office until his or her successor shall have been duly elected or until such officer's death or until such officer shall resign or shall have been removed in the manner hereinafter provided.
- **5.3** <u>Contract Rights of Officers</u>. Appointment of an officer or agent shall not of itself create contract rights. An officer's removal shall not affect the officer's contract rights, if any, with the Corporation. An officer's resignation shall not affect the Corporation's contract rights, if any, with the officer.
- **5.4** Chair or Co-Chairs. The Chair/Co-Chairs shall be the principal officer of the Corporation and shall preside as Chairperson at all meetings of the Board. The Chair/Co-Chairs will work together with the CEO to fulfill the overall goals of the Corporation. The Chair/Co-Chairs may sign, with the CEO, Secretary or any other officer of the Corporation authorized by the Board of Directors such documents and deeds of the Corporation as necessary or appropriate including, but not limited to, mortgages, bonds, contracts, or other instruments which the Board of Directors has authorized to be executed, except in cases where the signing and execution thereof shall be expressly delegated by the Directors or by these bylaws to some other officer or agent of the Corporation, or shall be required by law to be otherwise signed or executed, and in general, shall discharge all duties incident to the office of Chair and such other duties as may be assigned to him or her by the Directors from time to time.



- **5.5** <u>Vice Chairs and Assistant Vice Chairs</u>. During the absence or disability of the Chair, the Vice Chairs (in descending order) shall exercise all of the functions of the Chair. He or she shall have such powers and discharge such duties as may be assigned to him or her from time to time by the Board of Directors.
- **5.6 <u>Secretary</u>**. The Secretary shall: (1) be responsible for the keeping of the minutes of the Board of Directors and committee meetings in one or more locations provided for that purpose; (2) see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these bylaws or as required by law; (3) be custodian of the corporate records and of the seal, if any, of the corporation; and (4) in general, discharge all duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the President or by the Board of Directors.
- **5.7** <u>Treasurer</u>. If required by the Board of Directors, the Treasurer shall give a bond for the faithful discharge of his or her duties in such sum and with such surety or sureties as the Board of Directors shall determine. The Treasurer shall: (1) have charge and custody of and be responsible for all funds and securities of the Corporation; (2) receive and give receipts or cause to have receipts given for monies due and payable to the Corporation from any source whatsoever, and deposit or cause to have deposited all such moneys in the name of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other such depositories as shall be selected by the Board of Directors; and, (3) in general perform all the duties incident to the offices of Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the President or by the Board of Directors.
- **5.8** <u>Assistant Treasurers and Assistant Secretaries</u>. If required by the Board of Directors, the assistant Treasurers shall give bonds for the faithful discharge of their duties in such sums and with such sureties as the Board of Directors shall determine. The assistant Treasurers shall perform such duties as shall be assigned to them by the Treasurer or the President or the Board of Directors.
- 5.9 Chief Executive Officer (CEO). The CEO shall supervise and be principally responsible for the day-to-day administrative management of the Corporation and shall work closely with the Chair to ensure that all corporate functions are adequately carried out. He or she may sign, with the Secretary or any other officer of the Corporation authorized by the Board, such documents and deeds of the Corporation as necessary or appropriate including, but not limited to, mortgages, bonds, contracts, or other instruments which the Board has authorized to be executed, except in cases where the signing and execution thereof shall be expressly delegated by the Board or by these Bylaws to some other officer or agent of the Corporation, or shall be required by law to be otherwise signed or executed. The CEO shall be an Ex Officio member of the Board and of all Committees. He or she shall be a paid employee of the Corporation. The duties and responsibilities of the CEO shall include: (1) carrying out all policies established by the Board; (2) preparing an annual budget showing expected revenue and expenditures as required by the Board; (3) selecting, employing, training, controlling and discharging all other employees of the Corporation; (4) attending all meetings of the Board and Committees of the Board; (5) supervising the business affairs to ensure that funds are collected and obligations are paid out in a timely and advantageous fashion; (6) preparing and presenting to the



Board regular reports reflecting the effectuation of the goals and ministry of the Corporation. The CEO shall be hired by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE 6

Contracts, Loans, Checks and Deposits

- **6.1** <u>Contracts</u>. The Board may authorize any officer or agent to enter into any contract and execute and deliver any instruments in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation. Such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.
- **6.2** <u>Corporate Loans</u>. No loans shall be contracted on behalf of the Corporation, and no evidences of indebtedness shall be issued in the Corporation's name, unless authorized by a resolution of the Board. Such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.
- **6.3** <u>Checks, Drafts, Etc.</u> All checks, drafts or other orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the Corporation shall be signed by such officer or agent of the Corporation and in such manner as shall, from time to time, be determined by resolution of the Board. The CEO is authorized to make any payments up to \$5,000 or 1% of the last approved expense budget, whichever is greater, without board approval.
- **6.4** <u>Deposits and Contracts</u>. All funds of the Corporation not otherwise employed shall be deposited, from time to time, to the credit of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies and other depositories as the Board may select. The president and/or CEO is authorized herby to negotiate contracts for the purchase of goods or services in furtherance of the corporate objectives up to \$5,000.00, or 1% of the last approved expense budget, whichever is greater, without board approval.

ARTICLE 7

Executive and Other Committees

- **7.1** <u>Executive Committee</u>. The Board, by resolution adopted by the majority of all directors in office when the action is taken may create and appoint from among its members an Executive Committee consisting of two or more directors, who shall serve at the pleasure of the Board.
- **7.2** Authority of Executive Committee. When the Board is not in session, the Executive Committee shall have and may exercise all of the authority of the Board, unless otherwise specified in the resolution appointing the Executive Committee. Neither the Executive Committee, nor any other committee created by the Board, shall have the authority to: (a) amend, alter or repeal these Bylaws, (b) appoint or remove any member of the Executive Committee or any director or officer of the Corporation, (c) amend or restate the Articles, (d) adopt a plan of merger or consolidation with another corporation, (e) authorize the sale, lease, exchange or mortgage of all, or substantially all, of the property



and assets of the Corporation, (f) authorize the voluntary dissolution of the Corporation or adopt a plan for the distribution of the assets of the Corporation or (g) amend, alter or repeal any resolution of the Board.

- **a.** <u>Tenure and Qualification</u>. Each member of the Executive Committee shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the Board following such member's designation and until such member's successor shall be duly designated.
- **b.** <u>Meetings</u>. Sections 4.6 through 4.12 (which address meetings, notice of meetings and waiver of notice) shall apply to the Executive Committee and its members as well.
- **Quorum and Voting.** A majority of the members of the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum of the Executive Committee. If a quorum is present when a vote is taken, the affirmative vote of a majority of the members present shall be the act of the Executive Committee. A member who is present at a meeting of the Executive Committee when corporate action is taken shall be deemed to have assented to the action taken unless: (i) such member objects at the beginning of the meeting, or promptly upon such member's arrival, to holding it or transacting business at the meeting, (ii) such member's dissent or abstention from the action taken is entered in the minutes of the meeting or (iii) such member delivers written notice of the member's dissent or abstention to the presiding officer of the meeting before its adjournment or to the Corporation immediately after adjournment of the meeting. The right of dissent or abstention shall not be available to a Director who votes in favor of the action taken.
- **d.** <u>Vacancies</u>. Any vacancy in the Executive Committee may be filled by a resolution adopted by the Board in accordance with Section 7.1.
- **Resignations and Removal**. Any member of the Executive Committee may be removed at any time, with or without cause, by resolution adopted by the Board. Any member of the Executive Committee may resign from the Executive Committee at any time by giving written notice to the Board, and resignation shall be effective when the notice is delivered unless the notice specifies a later effective date.
- 7.3 Other Committees. The Board, by resolution adopted by the majority of all directors in office when the action is taken, may create and appoint from among its members such other committees, consisting of two or more directors, as from time to time it may consider necessary or appropriate to conduct the affairs of the Corporation. Each such committee shall have such power and authority as the Board may, from time to time, establish for it. The tenure and qualifications of the members of each committee, the time, place and organization of such committee's meetings, the notice required to call any such meeting, the number of members of each such committee that shall constitute a quorum, the affirmative vote of the committee members required effectively to take action at any meeting at which a quorum is present, the action that any such committee can take without a meeting, the method in which a vacancy among the members of such committee can be filled and the procedures by which resignations and removals of members of such committee shall be acted upon or accomplished, shall be fixed by



the resolution adopted by the Board relative to such matters, subject to the provisions of Tennessee law.

ARTICLE 8

Corporate Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE 9

Amendments

Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary contained herein, the Corporation's Charter or these Bylaws may be altered, amended, restated or repealed by a majority vote of the Board present at any regular or special meeting of the Board; provide, however, no amendment may be made to the Charter or these Bylaws without thirty (30) days' prior notice to the Directors, unless such notice shall be waived unanimously by the Board.

ARTICLE 10

Fiscal Year

The Board shall have the power to fix, and from time-to-time change, the fiscal year of the Corporation.

ARTICLE 11

Miscellaneous

- **11.1** <u>Construction</u>. Unless the context specifically requires otherwise, any reference in these Bylaws to any gender shall include all other genders, any reference to the singular shall include the plural and any reference to the plural shall include the singular.
- 11.2 <u>Severability of Provisions</u>. Except as may conflict with the provisions of Article 2 of the Articles, if any provision of these Bylaws, or its application to any person or circumstances, is held invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of these Bylaws, or the application of such provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it was held to be invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby, and to this extent, the provisions of these Bylaws are severable.



11.3 <u>Insurance</u>. The Corporation may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any person who is or was a Director, officer, employee or agent of the Corporation, or who is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a Director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise, against any liability asserted against such person and incurred by such person in any such capacity, or arising out of his or her status as such, whether or not the Corporation would have the power to indemnify such person against such liability under the provisions of Articles of Incorporation.
