Organizational Purpose

The purpose of VSA arts Tennessee is to enrich the lives of people with disabilities in Tennessee through the arts and to create a greater awareness of disabilities through artistic endeavors.

Program Accomplishments October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005

Art Institute: A one-week summer art institute exposes children with disabilities to the dance, drama, literature, music and visual arts of various cultures.	Grants/Donations: Ticket Revenue: Expenses:	\$3,500 \$ 940 (\$6,099)
Young Soloists Competition: A statewide competition for vocalists and musicians with disabilities under the age of 25. The winner represents the State of Tennessee at the national competition. This is an opportunity for musicallytalented students and young professionals to earn scholarship funds and possibly an opportunity to perform in Washington, D.C. at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts.	Grants/Donations: Expenses:	\$ 200 (\$ 150)
Playwright Competition: The VSA arts Playwright Discovery Award invites middle and high school students to take a closer look at the world around them, examine how disability affects their lives and the lives of others, and express their views through the art of playwriting. Playwrights may write from their own experience or about an experience in the life of another person or fictional character. Young playwrights with and without disabilities are encouraged to submit a script. Entries may be the work of an individual student or collaboration by a group or class of students.	Grants/Donations: Expenses:	\$ 750 (\$ 165)
Awards of Excellence: An awards banquet that recognizes an outstanding professional and young artist with disabilities as well as an art educator and supporter of the arts.	Grants/Donations: Ticket Revenue: Expenses:	\$ 1,290 \$ 2,872 (\$ 2,260)

Festival: An annual festival held in conjunction with the ARC of Tennessee's MEGA conference showcasing artistic talent and efforts of those with disabilities.

Grants/Donations: \$ 1,000 Expenses: \$ 1,001

Performances and Exhibitions: Art exhibitions are hosted of the visual artwork of artists with disabilities. An annual show is held at the Legislative Plaza. Libraries and other venues are also used for exhibitions. Performances by those with disabilities are sponsored at the Bluebird Café and other venues.
