


Thanks to YOUR SUPPORT, FCS provided direct services to more than 60,000 Tennesseans last year.




COMMUNITY-BASED PROGRAMS

FCS is committed to taking its services where they are needed most. Our Community-Based Programs (CBP) are located at partner agencies or delivered directly to clients throughout the communities we serve. CBP served a total of 5,298 children and adults via our **Relative Caregiver Program,** school-based **Family Resource Centers**, and community-based mental health and adoption training.



COUNSELING

FCS has a long history of providing counseling and case management services, and all of our programs are based in clinical practice. **Counseling Services** are provided both at FCS offices and at more than 30 community-based partner locations. A total of 1,780 children and adults were served last fiscal year by agency-based and co-located FCS clinicians. **Crisis Services** handled 28,370 crisis calls on our 24/7 **Crisis Line.**



HEALTH CARE ACCESS

Access to affordable healthcare not only improves health outcomes, it impacts financial stability, employment, child wellbeing, and much more for vulnerable families. **Health Access** programs served 25,016 individuals through the **Get Covered Tenn** initiative, the **Health Assist** program, and **Language Services**.

Revenues

1. Development: Lower than budgeted: reduction in Grants.

2. United Way: Lower than budgeted; budget for FRCs is incorrect.

3. Government Contracts: Higher than budgeted; Get Covered TN contractor billing was higher than expected at the closing of Year 1 of the Grant and new contract with HCFA was not budgeted.

Expenses

- 5. Salaries: We have adjusted \$156,021.60 on Accrued Vacations.
- 6. Benefits: Higher than budgeted; new hires for Get Covered increased Unemployment insurance costs.
- 7. Professional Fees: Higher than budgeted; invoices from sub-contractors under Get Covered TN and Language Services.
- 8. Special Events: Higher than budgeted; expenses for Birthday Bash were higher due to changes in the scope of the event.
- 9. Supplies: Higher than budgeted; laptops and other supplies purchased for Get Covered.
- 10. Travel: Higher than budgeted; mileage reimbursement for interpreters was higher than budgeted due to a change in payment policy.
- 11. Specific Assistance: Higher than budgeted; supported by new grants.

12. Dues & Misc. expenses: Higher than budgeted. Funds returned as a result of an audit finding from DCS (\$11,871.97) and accounting for In-Kind expenses for DCRCP (\$13,943.47).

We have analyzed the financial statements, and the financial records supporting it. To the best of our knowledge, this statement is accurate and fairly represents the financial condition and operation of the agency.
