OVER 650 TEACHERS IN 320 CLASSROOMS HAVE RECEIVED LITERACY TRAINING AND CURRICULUM CREATED BY BRINGING BOOKS TO LIFE! THE PUPPET TRUCK HAS SERVED AN ADDITIONAL 3000-4000 CHILDREN IN PAST YEARS AND CONTINUES TO BRING THE NASHVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY MARIONETTE PRODUCTIONS TO THE MIDDLE TENNESSE COMMUNITY. THE ORGANIZATION SUPPORTS PROGRAMMING FOR TEENS THROUGH T.O.T.A.L., A GROUP OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS THAT ADVOCATES FOR THE LIBRARY AMONG PEERS AND THE COMMUNITY, PLANS AND IMPLEMENTS PROGRAMS FOR TEENS, AND REPRESENTS THE LIBRARY AT MIDDLE TENNESSEE EVENTS.
